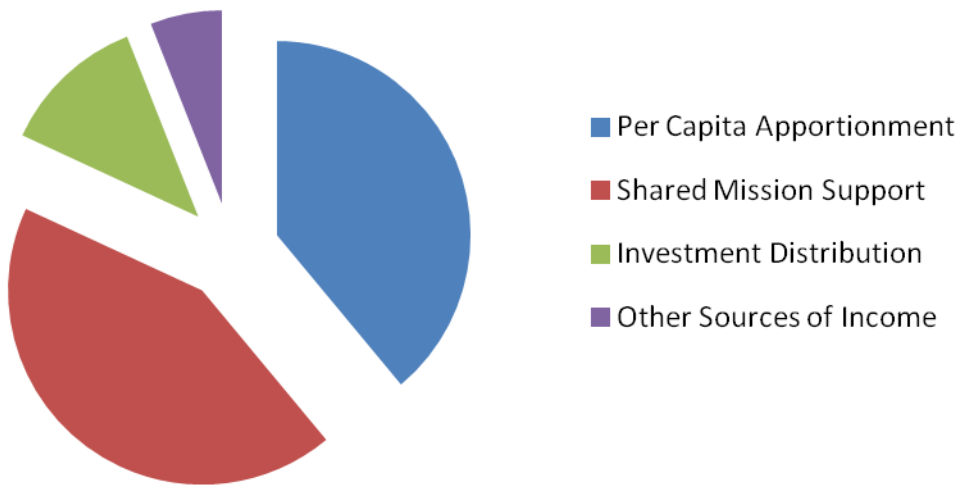


## Sources of Financial Support for the Presbytery of Lake Huron



### **Shared Mission Support**

Gifts and contributions, with no restrictions, for the overall support of the adopted budgets of Presbytery, Synod and General Assembly. Congregations budget a portion of their funds for shared mission support and send the money to the presbytery. Presbytery retains a percentage for its budget and sends a portion to Synod and General Assembly for their budgets.

### **Directed Mission Support**

Gifts given by churches to support specific parts of the budgets of the Presbytery, Synod and General Assembly Mission Council.

### **Per Capita Apportionment**

A means for all congregations to share in the costs of coordinating and evaluating mission and performing the ecclesiastical, legislative and judicial functions that the Presbytery, Synod and General Assembly are charged with by the Presbyterian Constitution. The Presbytery collects per capita from its churches; retains its portion to undergird the work of its mission and ministry and sends on the portions for the Synod and General Assembly.

### **Investment Distribution**

The Presbytery has adopted a spending formula by which a percentage of our investments are utilized in supporting the annual budget. A greater portion of the investment distribution is used to underwrite the per capita supported items of the budget in order to keep our per capita to a minimum.

The formula is:

Yev = year end value

Ayev = average year end value

$(yev5 + yev4 + yev3 + yev2 + yev1)/5 = Ayev$

$Ayev * \text{four percent} = \text{annual distribution}$
